Congratulations to our Year 12 cohort and in particular our HSC Dux Gleb Kozlov who attained an outstanding ATAR of 98.6 and was placed in the list of distinguished achievers where he was awarded a Band 6/E4 in three courses (3) which includes Mathematics Extensions 1 and 2 and Physics. This is a wonderful achievement and well-deserved, as he has worked with enormous commitment and diligence throughout the year.



Our students performed brilliantly in Mathematics Extension 1 and 2 and Mathematics Advanced. With the average exam mean of 97 in Extension 1 and 93 in Extension 2.
