



Fig 1 Level 4 Floor Plan

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We have whiteboards and data projectors available for use as well as a computer with internet access in all generic classrooms. The flexibility of the teaching learning resources means that there is a high degree of pedagogical diversity and flexibility to engage students in an exciting range of learning experiences. Movable chairs and tables means that seating arrangements are not fixed enabling small group work, team learning strategies and more traditional methodologies of teaching. Each general classroom provides an excellent teaching and learning environment that fully meets the demands of non-specialist subjects.

# Specialist Classrooms - Visual Arts, Computer Laboratory, Science, Drama

**Visual Arts** has large cupboards and lockers for storage of art materials, art works, and moveable classroom desks for a variety of teaching and learning environment configurations with mounting and air drying wires for paintings and drying of recently worked on art pieces. The Visual arts room is large and well lit with excellent natural light. There is a small art storage room behind the room with water and a data projector white board and computer are resident in the room. Hence a large range of teaching learning experiences and teaching methodologies with both practical work and theory is catered for facilitating excellent student work and progress.

**Computer Laboratory** Located on level 8 provides access to 30 computers each with internet access and suites of Microsoft and associated programs offering students excellence in learning. The computer laboratory has a roof mounted data projector that facilitates many pedagogical variations and presentation techniques. Air conditioned and very well lit students have access to a vast array of resources that are KLA specific. The computer laboratory also facilitates assessment of a range of practical skills in all KLAs. Research presentation oral exams, listening tasks are all successfully carried out in the Computer laboratory. The computers run the Windows 7 operating system for stability, ease of use and familiarity. ICT outcomes are addressed through the teaching of best practice research presentation and use of the programs so that the optimum combination facilitates the very best student work.

### Science

# **Ultimo TAFE Science Facility**

Specific Science practical work outcomes are met through Ultimo TAFE practical requirements with full fume cupboards, equipment shelves of all glass ware, pipettes, mass balances, full benches with stools and classroom area for differentiated pedagogy and presentation techniques. Data projectors and internet access are in the classroom/Lab area. Specific needs of the practical requirements of Science studied at Ultimo are met through the direct student engagement in performing first hand investigations, evaluation and justification of appropriate equipment for experimentation, the scientific method and best practice, scientific experimental techniques and genre specific writing skills are all developed at Ultimo. The facility is made available to years 7 -10 throughout the year. Weekly visits are encouraged.

# Macquarie Grammar's own State of the Art Science Facility approaches Installation

Fully serviced quotation and submission for funding for installation of a state of the art laboratory on Level 4 of the premises is being pursued. Complete with water and gas services, data projector and classroom area within the laboratory. A preparation room, fume cupboard and chemical storage facility are also included in the state of art facility. The proposed facility will rival the current practice of utilising the Ultimo TAFE facility and will provide a teaching learning resource of the highest standard. Currently, the Axis Group has an expression of interest active to build the facility in the near future.

Science lessons encompassing a range of differentiated learning experiences are carried out in the general classrooms, computer labs and the Ultimo TAFE. The full range of teaching learning experiences encompassing small group work, traditional teacher directed activities, student lead research and structuring of databases, tables, graphs, genre specific text types and practical tasks such as microscopy that do not require a traditional lab are carried out in these classrooms.

A Designated Library Space- Students access two reading pods where they may enjoy books, magazines and pamphlets on a variety of relevant topics. These resources are situated in common open areas of the school which function as social and eating areas during the breaks throughout the day. In addition to these areas, Macquarie Grammar has access to the State Library and does so, quite regularly. Students are offered membership to the State Library and are encouraged to enjoy the world class facilities it offers.

# The State Library of NSW

The State Library is within walking distance and is utilised by our teachers and students regularly. The State Library of NSW offers comprehensive computer and research facilities. Students are given lessons on how to use the library and offered membership. They are encouraged to use the library after and during school hours as is permissible. The diverse ranges of educational structures that present to the students by means of the library are exceptional. Sections of units are researchable and teachable in the library itself with the vast resources of the NSW State Library available to our teachers and students for exemplary teaching and learning practice. The State Library is used regularly with visitations on a frequency of approximately weekly when utilising a relevant teaching and learning program. Staff are encouraged to visit the library consistently. Specific units of work are programmed to be taught using the State Library exclusively. This in addition to the traditional classroom and its pedagogical reservoir extends the same population of student and teachers in a resource rich environment facilitating a diverse and exciting array of pedagogical technique and student evaluation procedures. Critical thinking, problem solving, research and synthetic skills that are traditionally taught at school are further developed and enriched by the external facility of the State Library.

**Sporting Facilities** – Macquarie is very fortunate to have access to world class sporting facilities within the immediate area. The Ian Thorpe Aquatic Centre is used regularly for swimming classes and swimming carnivals. This facility offers Macquarie students exceptional advantage to participate in learn-to-swim programs, swimming improvement programs and aquatic exercises. In addition, the reasonably close proximity of the Eastern Suburbs beaches has facilitated a learn-to-surf program for interested students.

The Cook Phillip Park Aquatic and Sporting Centre is also used for Basketball training as well as Badminton. Students have access to the state of the art facilities, in order to develop their gross motor aerobic capacity and general fitness.

The Domain is also utilised to train and develop coordination team building and aerobic/muscular fitness in a variety of team and individual sports.

Tournaments and House competitions are organised throughout the year in Table Tennis, Basketball, Swimming, and Athletics promoting a healthy competitive base that builds school spirit and pride. Excellent sporting performances are recognised on formal assemblies and through a house points system.

**The Supreme Courts of NSW** are also an excellent resource that is readily accessible for Macquarie Grammar students. It has been used to show case the trial procedure and relevant elements of the judicial system. As such, it represents a highly valued resource for KLAs dealing with associated subject material. Visitation facilitates an exceptional learning experience through repeated excursions advantaging the teaching learning environment of Macquarie Grammar.

### Indoor Recreational Space

The level eight Macquarie facility houses two championship quality table tennis tables that are available for use at appropriate times of the day. These are accompanied by an open area for eating and socialising with round tables and chairs. Students also have access to reading materials at this level. The level eight facility has microwaves, instant hot water, as well as cold filtered water.

The Level 2 facility has a large boardroom/dining table and chairs equipped with microwaves, hot and cold water and access to reading materials. It is a place of social interaction popular with the students.

Home rooms are used by Macquarie Students to organise their work. They often socialise in groups and form strong friendships in these rooms as they prepare for the days' lessons.

Level 10 offers an outdoor BBQ area that is frequented at breaks. It is secure with high glass walls surrounding the area ensuring student safety. The BBQ is used by teacher and student groups alike for celebrations and gatherings of a social manner.

### **Emergency Procedures and Relevant Facilities**

Regular evacuation and lock down procedures are carried out ensuring the student and staff population are safe at Macquarie Grammar School. The Building is equipped with fire stairs and fire doors that service each floor

appropriately. Disability provisions are in place with a wheel chair ramp and elevators providing safe access to all floors. All general classrooms are lockable and provide excellent safety in the case of an intruder.

### The Current Standard and State of Repair of Facilities

The Building at 225 Clarence Street is maintained to the highest of standards. The school established in 2004 and is regularly checked for flaws or weakness that may appear by the management on regular WHS inspections. The WHS committee then acts appropriately on any of the issues that may have arisen as a result of the inspections. Subsequent to this there is a Risk Management Hazard Plan developed with all appropriate actions carried out in order to maintain the safety of the School community. There is an onsite Building Manager readily contactable who coordinates the continued maintenance of the building. Macquarie Grammar school has a 'handy man' that performs any repairs or installations that may be necessary for the school in its day to day functioning. WHS issues that may arise from day to day are reported to the Principal and as such dealt with immediately if practicable otherwise the WHS committee resolves potential issues as soon as possible.

Relevant sections of the Explosives ACT 2003 and the Workplace Health and Safety ACT 2011 are complied with through the practice of Lock downs evacuation drills and WHS procedure. All new installations are fully compliant with all relevant acts that pertain to the work.

The anticipated installation of the Science facilities at Macquarie Grammar is compliant with all aspects of Council and of other relevant acts such as the Explosives Act 2003.

The Visual Art Studio is yet to incorporate a Kiln and as such Macquarie Grammar meets all WHS and safety requirements for the safe functioning of a school.
